We feel her euphoria writing *The Price of Salt* (later adapted into the film *Carol*), one of the first mainstream novels to feature two women in love. And we watch Highsmith in Positano, subsisting on little more than cigars and wine, gleefully conjuring *Mr Ripley*, the sociopathic anti-hero that would cement her reputation. In these pages Highsmith reflects on good and evil, loneliness and intimacy, sexuality and sacrifice, love and murder. She describes her tumultuous romantic relationships, alongside her sometimes dizzying
