Desde ese momento se inicia una extraña relación entre el vigilante, la mujer y el flujo de las corrientes marinas.

Este libro intenta explorar algunos caminos de debate sobre el complicado panorama de la medicina del nuevo siglo, mediante capítulos agrupados en tres temas de interés: "La Medicina Basada en Evidencias", "El encuentro entre pacientes y médicos", y "Las nuevas miradas a la medicina del siglo XXI".

Saranno esaminati sia i cambiamenti che sono intervenuti in ambito organizzativo del sistema sanitario che i nuovi orizzonti e le pratiche narrative che si confrontano con la società digitale, entro contesti che favoriscono l'acquisizione di un panorama di competenze multiplo ed interattivo. Il volume si chiude con un ritorno al paziente e alla sua storia, volta a presentare la potenza della narrazione e rendendo percepibile al lettore quanto sia necessario non perdere di vista la ricchezza, sia in termini clinici che epistemologici, dell'esperienza soggettiva.

Phantoms of War in Contemporary German Literature, Films and Discourse offers an up-to-date and comprehensive analysis of fundamental shifts in German cultural memory. Focusing on the resurgence of family stories in fiction, autobiography and in film, this study challenges the institutional boundaries of Germany's memory culture that have guided and arguably limited German identity debates. Essays on contemporary German literature are complemented by explorations of heritage films and museum discourse. Together these essays put forward a compelling theory of family narratives and a critical evaluation of generational discourse.

Soul-Health explores the connection between reading and healing. The act of reading engages deeply with our emotions and psychology, and this book broadens our understanding of that process by the surprising revelation that feeling bad has been understood as the best thing for mental and spiritual health. The mental and emotional impact of reading expanded in the Middle Ages into a therapeutic tool for improving the health of the soul - a state called salus animae - and focusing on later Medieval England, the present study explores a core set of religious texts that identify themselves as treatments for the soul. These same texts, however, evoke powerfully negative emotions. Soul-Health investigates each of these emotions, offering an analysis of how fear, penance, compassion and longing could work to promote the health of the soul, demonstrating how interest in mental and spiritual health far pre-dates the modern period, and is more complex and balanced than simply trying to achieve joy.
