The end-point assessment for lead adult care worker is made up of 2 components that must be taken in the following order: 1. Situational judgement test consisting of 60 questions, which has a 90-minute duration 2. Professional discussion, which has a 45-minute duration.

Strengths-based questions for social work assessments

healthcare settings. As well as covering Lead Adult Care Workers this standard also covers Lead Personal Assistants who can work at this senior level but they may only work directly for one individual who needs support and/or care services, usually within their own home.
