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To get your Alpine Guide Certification, you must complete: The 10-day Rock Guide Course (RGC) or the 5-day Alpine Skills Course (ASC). If you are pursuing IFMGA certification you will want to take the RGC. The 9-day Alpine Guide Course (AGC) The 5-day Ice Instructor Course (IIC) The 9-day Advanced Alpine Guide Course and Aspirant Exam (AAGC/AE)

ENSA in France, the oldest mountain and alpine guide association, charges 11 000 euros for 3 year training program. The MTS school of guides in the USA require aspirants complete 5-6 years of intensive training and charges 24 000 usd. The diploma is often issued after 10 years of intensive practice.

AMGA Certification: The American Mountain Guides Association (AMGA) certifies guides in three different disciplines: Rock, Alpine, and Ski. An individual can be certified at a variety of levels in each discipline. Once certified that individual has been deemed qualified by the AMGA to guide within that discipline within certain terrain guidelines (listed below).
