Jean-Michel Frank (1895-1941) is a mythical figure in the decorative arts. His style described as "poor luxury" is just as paradoxical as his life between parties and solitude, with loyal friendships for poets, artists who were decisive in the development of his aesthetic, but also his clients, people of the world of fashion or intellectuals. Forcing them to get rid of their objects, their paintings and their

carpets, Frank invented for them places conducive to meditation and dreams, furniture of perfect simplicity, close to a French neoclassicism stripped of its ornaments. Indifferent to the great debates of the first half of a twentieth century, Jean-Michel Frank did not seek to build a new world or to cling to a nostalgic past. With elegance, he broke conventions, cleaned up the places of their history. Perhaps it is this mixture of lightness and rigor, of dreams and poetry, this very current diversion of objects and materials that have led so many decorators and contemporary designers to claim him.

This book takes an interdisciplinary, transnational and cross-cultural approach to reflect on, critically examine and challenge the surprisingly robust practice of making art after death in an artist's name, through the lenses of scholars from the fields of art history, economics and law, as well as practicing artists. Works of art conceived as multiples, such as sculptures, etchings, prints, photographs and conceptual art, can be—and often are—remade from original models and plans long after the artist has passed. Recent sales have suggested a growing market embrace of posthumous works, contemporaneous with questioning on the part of art history. Legal norms seem unready for this surge in posthumous production and are beset by conflict across jurisdictions. Non-Western approaches to posthumous art, from Chinese emulations of non-living artists to Native American performances, take into account rituals of generational passage at odds with contemporary, market-driven approaches. The book will be of interest to scholars working in art history, the art market, art law, art management, museum studies and economics.

« Tout l'art du passé, de toutes les époques, de toutes les civilisations, surgit devant moi, tout est simultané comme si l'espace prenait la place du temps. » Alberto Giacometti n'est pas seulement un artiste majeur du XXe siècle : il est aussi l'une de ses personnalités les plus originales. Fruit de recherches nouvelles, cet ouvrage nous introduit dans l'intimité d'un

artiste hanté par son œuvre, toujours poussé en avant par une exigence sans concession. Après une jeunesse passée dans l'atelier de son père en Suisse, puis dans celui du sculpteur Antoine Bourdelle à Paris, le jeune artiste s'affranchit de ses premiers mentors en se tournant vers le cubisme, puis le surréalisme. Malgré la reconnaissance quasi-instantanée de son travail et l'amitié admirative d'André Breton, il se détourne rapidement des objets surréalistes qui l'ont rendu célèbre, pour s'engager dans une échappée solitaire qui le mènera à la marge des courants dominants. Ami des plus grands artistes et intellectuels, il trace son sillon personnel dans l'intimité solitaire de son mythique atelier de Montparnasse. Profondément attaché à la représentation humaine, influencé par les arts archaïques et non occidentaux, il s'éloigne d'une représentation naturaliste, pour adopter une vision synthétique et parfois hallucinée de la figure, chargée d'une puissance mystérieuse. Catherine Grenier nous livre le destin et le parcours singulier d'Alberto Giacometti, de sa vie et de son œuvre, dans une biographie à lire comme un roman.
