The collection began in the 1950s when the Very Reverend Eric Milner-White, Dean of York, left his collection of studio pottery to York Art Gallery. Milner-White began collecting in 1925 when there were few other collectors interested in modern pottery and he was able to buy some of the biggest and best works.

Our Festival of Nine Lessons and Carols was first held on Christmas Eve 1918. It was planned by Eric Milner-White, who at the age of thirty-four had just been appointed Dean of King's after experience as an army chaplain which had convinced him that the Church of England needed more imaginative worship.
