sections. Its organization is much more flexible, as it revolves around the themes being discussed from the literature. I have

Literature reviews come in many forms. They can be part of a research paper, for example as part of the Introduction section. They can be one chapter of a doctoral dissertation. Literature reviews can also “stand alone” as separate articles by themselves.

A research literature review is a critical analysis of existing literature on a particular research topic. In a research paper you use the literature as a foundation and as support for a new insight that you contribute.

A literature review is the research and evaluation of the available literature in your chosen topic area. It includes a survey of scholarly sources to provide an overview of the current research and available data and knowledge. These sources include books, journal articles, and newspapers, that relate to your research question.

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Scholarly literature can be of different types; some of which require that researchers conduct an original study, whereas others can be based on existing research. Usually, a literature review can be described as an objective, concise, and critical summary of published research literature pertinent to the subject being researched in an article. A literature review can be an end in itself (an analysis of what is known about a topic) or a prologue to and rationale for engaging in primary research.

A literature review is a critical summary of what the scientific literature says about your specific topic or question. Often student research in APA fields falls into this category. Your professor might ask you to write this kind of paper to demonstrate your familiarity with work in the field pertinent to the research you hope to conduct.

A literature review is a study – or, more accurately, a survey – involving scholarly material, with the aim to discuss published information about a specific topic or research question. Therefore, to write a literature review, it is compulsory that you are an expert in the object of study.

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
