Each control station should be clearly labeled, and should be located so that the operation of the conveyor is visible from the control station. Guards, safety devices, and safety labels should be installed in the correct locations and maintained in good repair. Support systems for the conveyor should be securely anchored.

Conveyors shall be locked out or otherwise rendered inoperable, and tagged out with a "Do Not Operate" tag during repairs and when operation is hazardous to employees performing maintenance work. Not properly locking out and tagging conveyors is one of the most common culprits of serious injury and death in warehouses and manufacturing facilities.

Screw conveyors shall be guarded to prevent employee contact with turning flights. 1926.555 (a) (5) Where a conveyor passes over work areas, aisles, or thoroughfares, suitable guards shall be provided to protect employees required to work below the conveyors. 1926.555 (a) (6)

Screw conveyor accidents can be avoided by implementation and enforcement of an in-plant safety program, and by training employees to follow certain basic safety rules: •Covers, gratings, and guards shall be securely fastened before operating the conveyor. Conveyors should be provided with solid covers, securely fastened.
